

Maths

Work through an Arithmetic Paper available on our Year 2 class page. Remember to show your working out using the methods we have learnt including number lines for adding and subtracting and using arrays when multiplying and dividing.

We will be learning about fractions. Can you find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ of items of food in your home? For example, a cake or pizza. Can you create equal parts? Take a photo of your learning.

Handwriting

Practise your neat joined up handwriting by copying out the paragraph about castles on our Year 2 class page. Remember to use a sharp pencil and lined paper.

Reading

Complete 'King Charles III' Reading Comprehension task available to download from our Year 2 class page. There are three different levels, choose which one is most suitable for you.



Create a character profile including describing their appearance, personality, likes and dislikes. You may like to choose a character of your choice or find a King or Queen character in a book you may have.

Science

We will be celebrating **British Science Week 13th – 17th March** and the theme for this year is '**Connections!**'.

Create a poster to show connections of the world and science. You may like to think about these elements:

- How plants are connected to us- compare what plants need to grow and what humans need.
- You could choose one item of food and find out how it grows from farm to food and sold in shops.
- How animals are connected. You could think about what foods they eat (create a food chain) or how they are connected to their habitats.
