What is Red Nose Day?

- Red Nose Day is a fundraising event run by Comic Relief.
- Comic Relief is a UK charity which aims to create a world free from poverty.
- The money raised is used to transform lives in the UK and around the world.

Your donations can support incredible projects which help children to be happier, families stronger, women safer, communities prouder and millions of lives fairer.

Where does the money go?

- £5 could provide school stationery to a child living in poverty in South Africa.
